#### **Featured Recipes**

Warm up with comfort food on cold winter days.

#### Easy Crock Pot Chicken

2 lbs boneless skinless chicken breast

1 packet ranch seasoning

1 packet taco seasoning

2 blocks cream cheese (8oz)

Put ingredients in crock pot. Cook on medium for 6 hours. Shred chicken. Serve on taco shells with all the fixings (lettuce, tomato, olives, onions, jalapenos etc.) or use as a dip.

#### Spicy Chicken Stuffed Peppers

4 red bell peppers

3 cloves of garlic (finely chopped)

1 small chili pepper (finely chopped)

1 pound spicy chicken sausage

1 ½ cup couscous

4 T tomato paste

½ cup shredded Pepper Jack Cheese

1 T olive oil

2 T butter

Salt and pepper to taste



Cut peppers in half lengthwise. Remove seeds. Cover peppers in olive oil. Bake for 20 minutes at 425 degrees with the cut side up, until soft and brown. Melt butter in pan. Add sausage and garlic. Cook until brown. Add couscous and tomato paste until all coated. Then add 2 cups water. Boil. Put mixture in cooked peppers and top with cheese.
