FDA Egg Facility Inspections

Having an effective Salmonella Enteritidis (SE) prevention plan is necessary for all egg facilities. FDA inspections have resumed. Now is the time to get prepared! Avoid noncompliance by reviewing the most common deviations cited by FDA inspectors:

- No SE plan or inadequate SE Plan.
- Failure to prevent stray poultry, wild birds, cats or other animals from entering the poultry house.
- Failure to monitor for rodents by appropriate method.
- Failure to maintain appropriate records.
- Failure to complete records (i.e. farm name, date and time of activity, signature or initials).
- Faliure to refrigerate eggs at or below 45 degrees beginning 36 hours after time of lay.
- Failure to conduct environmental testing at 40 to 45 weeks of age.
- Failure to limit visitors on the farm.

Make sure your Salmonella enteritidis (SE) plan is complete and compliant today!

Crab Salad

If your job is to take care

2 pounds crabmeat

 $2 \ 1/2 \ cups \ chopped \ celery$

8 tablespoons mayonnaise

2 teaspoons celery seed

1 pinch paprika

2 1/2 tablespoons white sugar

1/2 tablespoon ground black pepper

1 teaspoon Old Bay Seasoning TM

2 teaspoons dried parsley

Mix all ingredients and chill. Serve with Ritz crackers.

Creamy Cauliflower Broccoli Salad

- 1 bunch broccoli chopped
- 1 head cauliflower florets
- 1/2 red onion sliced thin
- 1 cup bacon diced
- 1/2 cup dried cranberries (optional)
- 1 cup salad dressing
- 2 tablespoons white wine vinegar
- 1/4 cup sugar
- 1/2 cup sunflower seeds

Combine broccoli, cauliflower, onion, bacon, and dried cranberries. In a separate bowl, whisk together the salad dressing, vinegar, and sugar. Pour over salad and toss. Chill. Stir in sunflower seeds just before serving.
