Viking and Blue River organic seeds offer early payment discounts. In addition to the opportunity to receive discounts, placing your order early gives you the best chance to receive the variety, and in some cases the seed size you prefer. In the past many of the organic varieties have been booked up by March.

- Viking corn and soybeans offer a 6% discount paid for by December 15.
- Blue River corn and alfalfa offers a 5% discount paid for by December 31.

Featured Recipe: No Bake Caramel Pretzel Crack Bars!

These bars are SO easy and crazy delicious. It's addictive!

- 11.5 oz bag of Hershey's Milk Chocolate Chips
- 11 oz bag of Kraft Caramel Bits
- ½ Cup Reese's Peanut Butter Chips
- 8 oz of Mini Twist Pretzels



In a small glass bowl, add the Hershey chocolate chips (Reserve about ¼ cup of chips for later). Melt in microwave in 20 second intervals until melted.

Spread the melted chocolate on a parchment lined cookie sheet. Place pretzels on top of the chocolate, they can overlap. Place the Kraft caramel bits in a bowl with 2 Tablespoons of water and melt in microwave for 1 ½ minutes to 2 minutes. Once melted drizzle and spread over the pretzels. Let Cool.

Melt the reserved ¼ cup of chocolate chips in the microwave and drizzle over the cooled caramel. Repeat with the Reese's peanut butter chips. Let Bars cool completely then Enjoy
