Time to Update Your Budget for 2020

December is a great time to complete your 2020 budget. A budget is always a work in progress and should be updated and changed during the year as your estimated revenues and costs change. A budget is an important management tool and can be useful as you make decisions throughout the year.

Start by reviewing 2019 and identifying how 2020 may be different. It is essential to make realistic assumptions and avoid overestimating or underestimating revenue and expense. Spend some time considering your fixed and variable cost. Managing your fixed costs can result in more efficient management.

Once the draft of your budget is complete, look back at it regularly as you review your cash flow, marketing, cost control, and risk management plans. Keep in mind that the budget is a guideline and should be updated throughout the year as the season progresses. Andes Mint Muddy Buddies

9 cups Rice Chex cereal 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips 1/2 cup smooth peanut butter 1/4 cup butter (1/2 stick) - room temperature 1 teaspoon vanilla extract 1 1/2 cups powdered sugar



Mint flavored M&M's (dark green, light green, and white) Hershey Andes Mint bars (broken into smaller pieces)

Microwave chocolate chips, peanut butter, and butter for 1 minute and stir. Microwave for an additional 30 seconds until the mixture is smooth and creamy. Stir in the vanilla extract.

Pour mixture over the cereal and stir to coat evenly. Transfer the cereal into a gallon-sized Ziploc bag. Pour the powdered sugar into the bag and seal. Gently shake until all of the pieces are coated. Pour out the cereal onto the baking sheet lined with wax paper and spread out until cooled, add mint flavored M&M's and Andes Mint pieces.

Chocolate Chow Mein Noodle Cookies (AKA Reindeer Poop)

1 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips 1 cup peanut butterscotch chips 2 1/2 cups chow mein noodles 1/2 cup salted peanuts

In a medium saucepan, melt chocolate chips and peanut butter chips over low-medium heat until completely melted. Remove saucepan from the stove. Add chow mein noodles and peanuts to the saucepan and mix. Spoon out tablespoon-size mixture and place onto a wax paper lined cookies sheet. Continue doing this until you have no more mixture left. Place in refrigerator for 2 hours before serving.
