Seed Discount Update

With a busy harvest season upon us, we wanted to send out a reminder of the early order and early payment discounts available on certain types of Viking and Blue River organic seeds.

Early Order Discounts

There will be a \$10 per bag discount for Viking organic corn and Viking organic alfalfa for orders placed through October 15th, plus an additional 9% discount for payment by October 15th on orders of organic corn and alfalfa.

The will also be a \$5 per bag early order discount for Blue River organic corn and alfalfa ordered by October 30th, and an additional 8% discount for payment by October 30th on orders of organic corn and alfalfa.

We still have organic fall rye and organic winter wheat seed on hand for immediate pickup.

Organic Grain Receiving Guidelines

- CFS can only receive certified organic grain.
- A copy of your current organic certificate must be on file prior to unloading grain.
- GMO testing will be completed on every load of corn and soybeans.
- Testing for vomotoxin will be completed on every load of barley, rye, and wheat.
- No Off-grade grains will be accepted (i.e. moldy, sour, mixed grains).
- Every load will require a complete "Clean Truck Affidavit." We have copies in our office.

Featured Recipe – Pumpkin Bread

- 3 ¹/₂ cups flour 1 ¹/₂ tsp. salt 3 cups sugar 2 tsp baking soda 1 tbsp. cinnamon 4 eggs
- 15 oz. can of pumpkin
 1 cup oil
 ³/₄ cup water
 ¹/₂ cup chopped walnuts (optional)
 ¹/₂ cup raisins (optional)



Stir flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon and sugar together. Add oil, eggs, water and pumpkin. Pour into large bread ban. Add walnuts and raisins if desired. Bake at 350 for 35-45 minutes.
